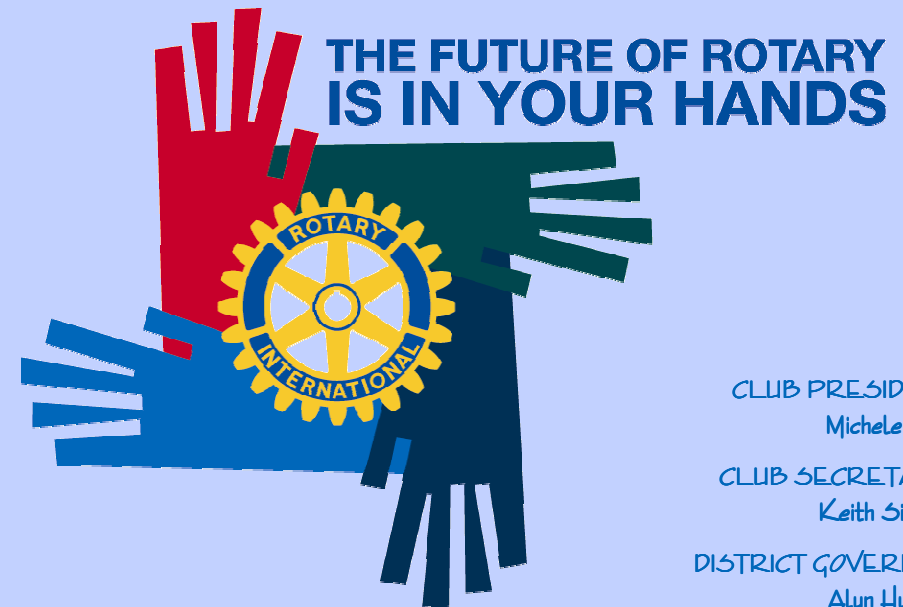

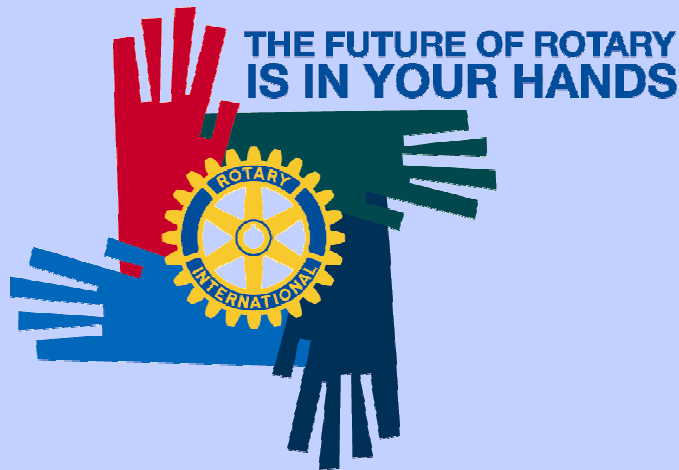

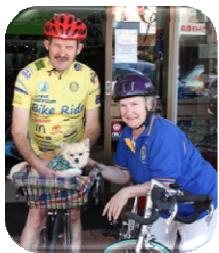

*Steve Pace—Pub life—coming to Whyalla; the experience*
