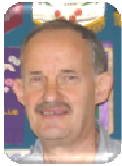

Perry introduced Bob to the meeting telling us that Bob came to Whyalla as a very young boy and he was a Rotaractor to the club but he has never been a speaker at the club.

Bob started saving in 2008 and in February this year Bob and his family went to Canada to the Winter Olympics. They stayed in an apartment in North Vancouver just 69 Kilometres away from Whistler, where many of the events took place. He took us through the events they went to, telling us interesting anecdotes about each one. He told us about an amazing accident where a woman, bounced, flew, tumbled and then got up and walked away. Other stories included, meeting Brett Desmond (from Whyalla) when they went for a coffee; all the signs were in English and French; the snow pictures and sculptures cut out with handsaws; Seeing Mark Beretta from Sunrise; going from peak to peak in the gondola, the scenery was indeed breath taking.

Bob is very enthusiastic and knowledgeable about the sportsmen and women in just about all the events and he was very happy to be at the best ever medal win for Australia in the Winter Olympics.
