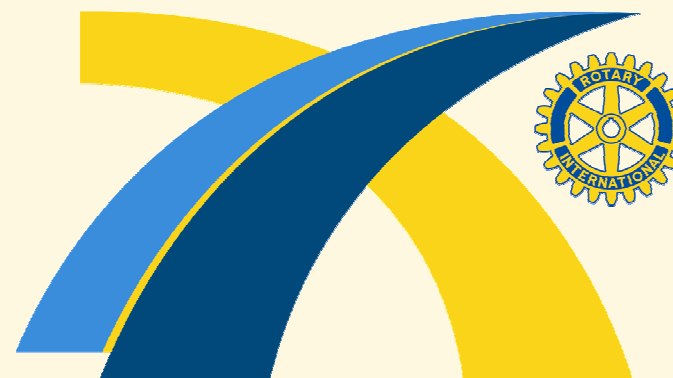

Rotary Foundation

John was reporting on his attendance at the Rotary Foundation Seminar in Adelaide in August.

This included members from both SA Districts and there were about 160 people in attendance. he thought that the speakers were very good.

One speaker said that there were 100 Clubs between the two Districts, but put forward the suspicion, that within ten years, this could be down to only 25 Clubs.

Several Clubs gave their details on membership.

"Housekeeping" was a major topic and Clubs listed their main points.

Meals were the number one concern among Members and this could impact on membership. John felt that our Club was well served in this regard.

Number two concern was programme and it was felt that it had to be interesting and varied. John Cagney, who is in his second year, is doing a good job for us, but it may be a job that requires more than one person.

Number three was leadership within the clubs, as Presidents could have an adverse effect on clubs. Again, John felt that our Club was not liable to have this problem, as we have a broad leadership group within the Club.

Number four was about club structure, as the style of meetings vary greatly between different Clubs, but this should be structured to meet the needs of the Members.

Changing family lives are affecting clubs, John quoted earlier, where ladies like his mother were members of the Inner Wheel but now, most wives of Members work and we weren't sure if Inner Wheel still exists.

All Service Clubs are struggling for members and to counteract this, Rotary is looking to attract members via the new types of communication in Twitter and Facebook.

He concluded by suggesting that what we do as a club should be considered.
