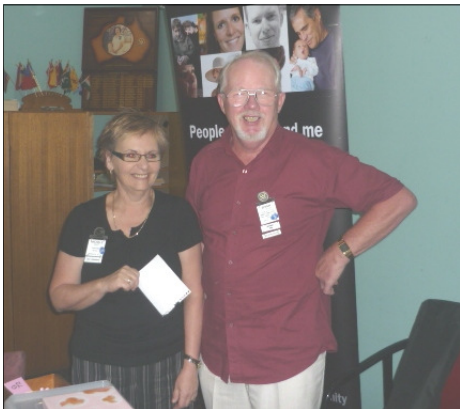

The FAIMous Brian Moodie aka George Clooney**Faim In Samoa**

This week we were privileged to hear Brian speak on a couple of his Faim adventures, this time in Samoa, in the mid 90's.

We were amazed at Brian's ability to recall the events of these times, given that they took place so long ago and these were two of twelve such trips he made to the Pacific region, rebuilding schools and other buildings, often damaged as cyclones and tsunamis passed through from time to time.

Brian provided commentary as we watched a slide show and video of the culture and lifestyle of the indigenous people and the projects he and the teams worked on.

With Samoa being on the other side of the International Date Line, on one trip, a team member left Australia on his birthday, and arrived in Samoa the day before and had another birthday the following day.
