# The FAIMous Brian Moodie aka George Clooney Faim In Samoa

This week we were privileged to hear Brian speak on a couple of his Faim adventures, this time in Samoa, in the mid 90's.

We were amazed at Brian's ability to recall the events of these times, given that the took place so long ago and these were two of twelve such trips he made to the Pacific region, rebuilding schools and other buildings, often damaged as cyclones and tsunamis passed through from time to time.
