AG Tim Clements, The Future Leaders Seminar

AG Tim, spoke to us tonight on his trip to the Future Leaders Seminar in Brisbane. He attended the seminar with Sue. The topics presented and the subject for later discussion groups included: Across the Rotary World; Future Good Leadership in Rotary; To be a good Leader; Effective Communication; Social Media; the rotary foundation; Hypothetical—Rotary in 2050; Future Leadership Opportunities.

Cultivate the RIGHT partnerships—committees, sponsors etc

Clear goals— Having a 3—5 year plan is a must

'Our customers' are the people who benefit from our activities—thus our activities must be tailored to what our community wants!

It is amazing what can be achieved if nobody cares who gets the credit! There is no 'I' in Rotary but there is a 'WE'
