Mobile Catering Unit—Soto discussed with the meeting a fan for the hot end of the van. David and Soto to have further discussion.



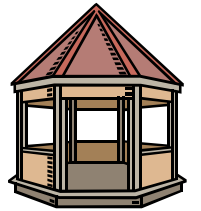
The Club Rooms— Soto is looking at Floating floors for the small room in the pavilion. He is also pricing Tables and chairs.
