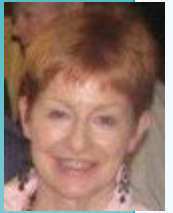

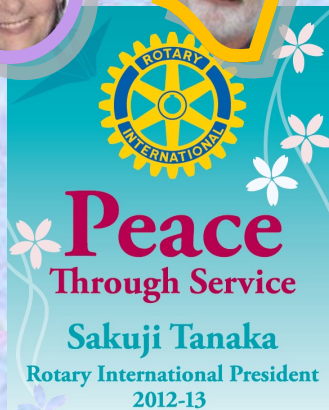

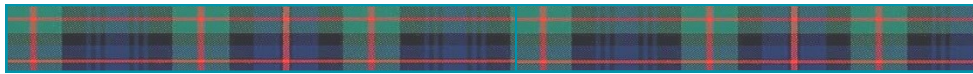

Whyalla's Assets are long overdue for upgrading & the plan allows considerable capital expenditure for the most serious & visible issues first & to implement planned progressive maintenance & improvements over the life of the plan.

The CDB, the Foreshore, the Gateways into Whyalla, Community Services, Airport, Visitor Centre, and of course roads & aptly after all the recent rainfall a thorough investigation of our stormwater system. Funded by a 6% rate increase, adequate budgets & a thorough understanding of the plan will return annual surpluses. Well done!
