



Apex issued free milk to children in 1937and 60% of Apexians went to WW2 which prompted Apex to organise chest x-rays for returned servicemen to look for T.B.

Besides Whyalla Apex organising the yearly Xmas pageant and after party, Damien's main passion at the moment is the Apex outback Postie Cycle ride to raise money for families who have a child needing cancer treatment. This ride has raised enough money to pay for "David's Place" which can house a family from the bush while they get cancer treatment for a child.
