ATTENDANCE AND APOLOGIES

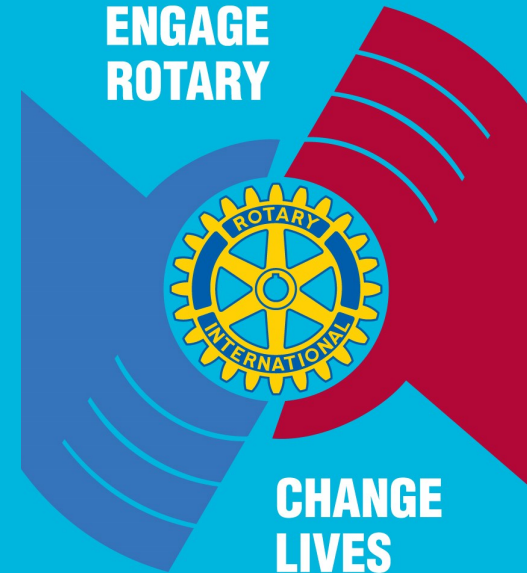

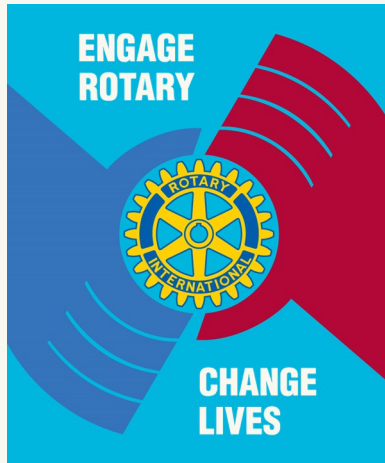

Guest speakers -

John Ward, Margaret Folkard & Jason Ward - Gnomonists from Sundials Australia.

Margaret and John have been making sundials since 1977, and John went on a Churchill fellowship. John has written a book entitled "Sundials of Australia" and now wants to make a hard cover coffee table version and is looking for a \$60k sponsor.

Hadrian's Wall has a couple of sundials in it, so the technology is not new, but the wall was high enough to keep Brian and Jane's ancestors back from ravaging the English.

The oldest sundial in Australia is from 1830 and is now in Canberra.

The oldest sundial standing in the world is from 2500BC. The ancient Egyptians had a mobile sundial which was a bent stick that they carried on their belt and when needed would be stuck in the ground and positioned expertly to tell the time - the start of the clock watchers.

Our sundial has an equatorial ring which means that each hourly division is equal on the dial - and coincidentally or not each hour lines up with the gear teeth on our rotary emblem.

If we were to transport our sundial to the equator we would tilt it to be horizontal for it to work.

Our sundial, the globe countries and the noon marker are all made from 316 stainless steel.
