ATTENDANCE AND APOLOGIES

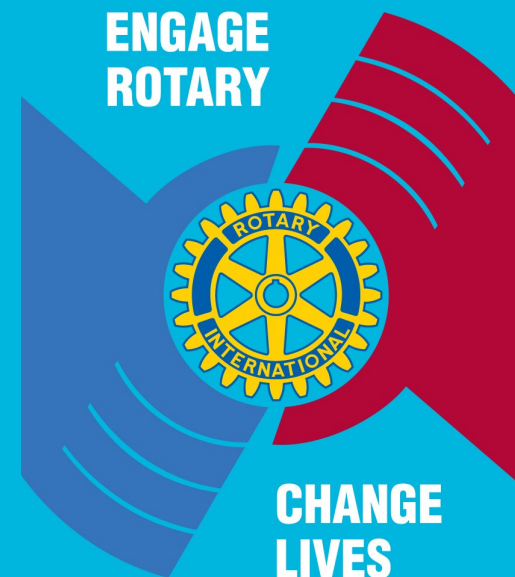

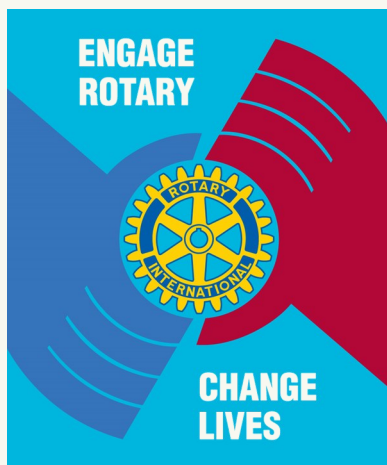
