ATTENDANCE AND APOLOGIES

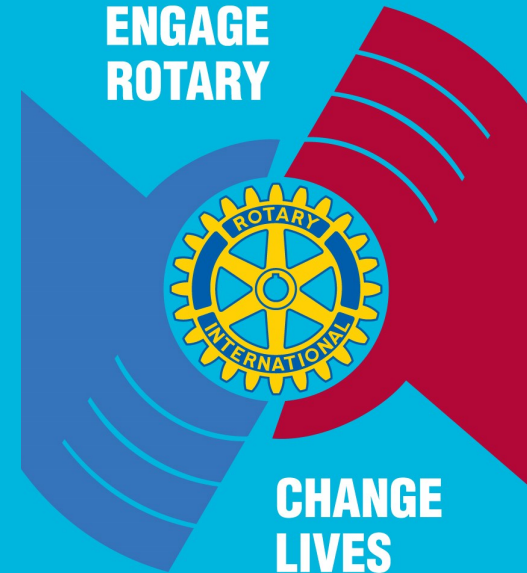

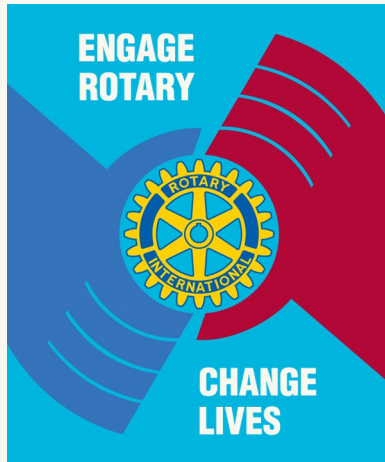

Guest Speaker PDG Ed King - The Foundation and Grants

The Rotary Foundation is Rotary's only charity.

Every cent spent is on Rotary Projects.

World reach for the Foundation is greater than the United Nations.

The Foundation can go where politicians and religions can't or haven't yet.

The Foundation started with \$26.50 in 1917.

The first donation by the Foundation was \$500 to children crippled by Polio.

By 1932 saw \$50,000 in the bank.

In 1947 Paul Harris died, and \$10 donations to honour him raised \$1.775Million.

1957 and the Paul Harris Fellow was established that cost \$1000 to purchase - it still does!

The finances of the Foundation are very transparent - only 3% of earnings are used on administration costs.

The six areas of The Foundation focus are:

- Peace and conflict prevention / resolution
- Disease prevention and treatment
- Water and sanitation
- Maternal and childcare
- Basic education and literacy
- Economic and community development

Polio Plus has only three countries left to cure: Pakistan, Afganistan and Nigeria. Bill and Melinda Gates are now donating \$2 for every \$1 from the Foundation. India has just achieved 3 years without a new case of polio reported, which is the definition of a country being polio free.

District grant applications are now relatively easy to fill out, but somebody from the club must attend the grant seminar.
