ATTENDANCE AND APOLOGIES

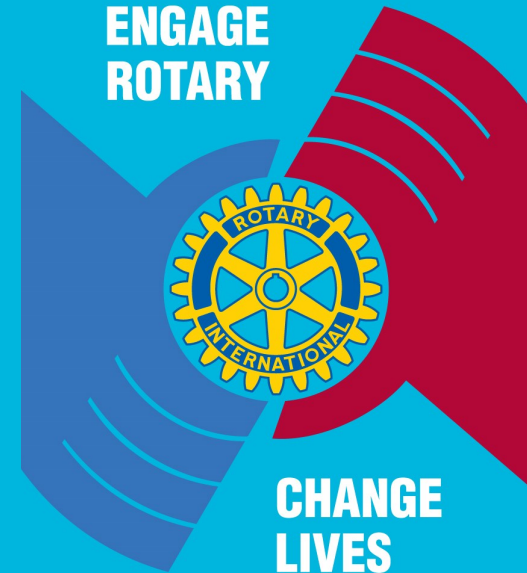

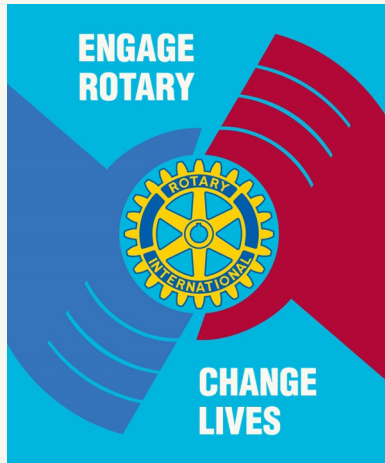
