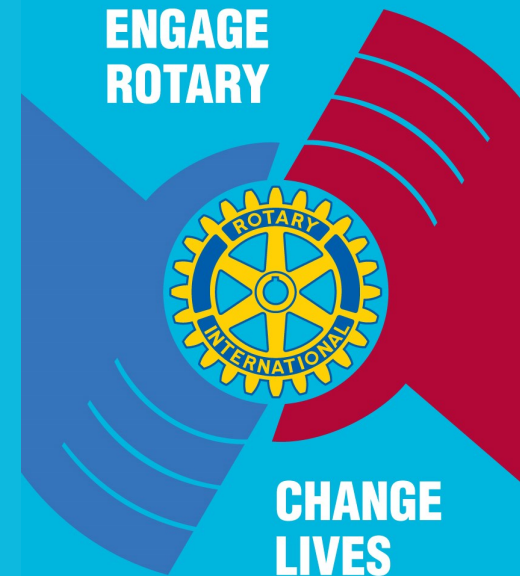

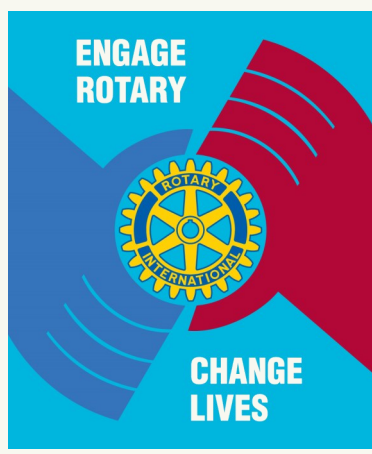

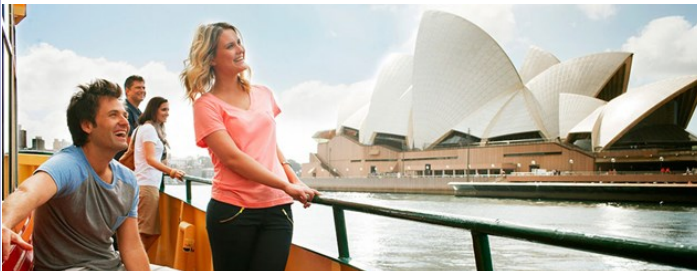

### GUEST SPEAKER Brianna Chappell, Opteon (formerly Southwick Goodyear) Property Valuations



Since August Last year Brianna has lived in Whyalla working with Opteon. She plays netball with the Kiwis and barracks for The Power. She came to Whyalla with her partner, Alan, who works with A&E. Brianna grew up in Adelaide, with three older brothers. Her father had the commercial building company Aj Chappell. This was an environment she grew up in and gave

her and introduction into Property Work. During her years studying she worked in the Real Estate office Jones Lang Lasalle as a research analyst.

Brianna also told us about a very interesting paper she wrote on the impact of Olympic Dam. Working with Southwick Goodyear, she secured a good grounding under the watchful eye of Glen Goodyear who has now retired and Brianna is in the office on her own. As the Residential Property Valuer Glen taught her a lot of what she now knows.
