Alistair Stevenson - A Plan for the Van

Alistair and Soto have been dreaming, and would like us to help that dream to become a reality.

Our present Mobile Catering Unit is nearing the end of its useful life. It must be 30 years old by now and has had quite a number of makeovers. Chances are that it does not meet current legal and insurance requirements in its current state.

Alistair presented the proposal to cut down the existing chassis from approx 9.8 m to 6.5m and reconstruct the van. Total cost is expected to be just under \$14,000 and take 9 months to complete. Assistance in terms of labour will be required on a weekly basis to enable all of this to happen between August and April.

A proposal and drawings of the interior and electrical layout were provided for discussion. Alistair pointed out that this is conceptual and that members ideas and suggestions were required before a final proposal is ready for decision.
