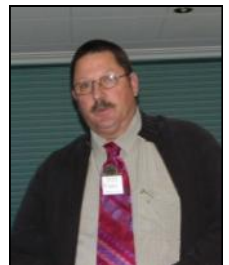
### *Peter Nichols - RFDS Bash*

Peter retraced the steps of the 2007 Lions 'Tag-a-long Trek' which covered some 2,760 kilometres in 8 days and supports the Royal Flying Doctor Service. The team comprised, Leon Jarvis, Allan Smith, Keith Dempsey and of course, Peter.

The tour went from Wilmington to Whyalla via Kimba, Ceduna, Googs Lake, Mt. Finke, Mt. Ives and Kokatha Station, stopping frequently to pick up supplies. This was the type of tour where anything goes. Fines are levied with abandon and gamesmanship is high in the fundraising stakes. Peter took the initiative to attach magnetic sponsorship signs on his vehicle however they were frequently removed to other vehicles on a daily basis and Peter had great pleasure in seeing the culprits fined at the end of each day.

The 2009 trek starts at Renmark in September and will head north until reaching Birdsville on day four. Then on to Innaminka, through Walkers crossing and on to Silverton and Broken Hill where the trek finishes.

Peter would like us to support the RFDS by sponsoring a vehicle this year. Cost would be \$100 per person in the vehicle and plans to hold a fundraising dinner.
