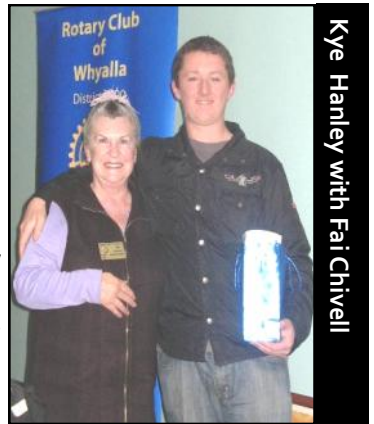
Raised \$46 and was won by Jack.
