2. **FINANCE** - Keith. ▶ Reports for the Projects account and Club Admin Account were distributed and questions answered.
3. **MEMBERSHIP SEMINAR** - Tim & Jane. The seminar was most worthwhile and covered club development issues not simply membership. There was a break-out session focusing on club health and membership. There was also an explanation of the Club Visioning process, Social Media and Marketing. Most of the speakers were provided as video’s of their presentations at the earlier seminar in Adelaide but were still worthwhile. Also of interest was a presentation on the various generations from the Baby Boomers through to Generations X, Y & Z and tips for each on how to get on with the others. ## ASSEMBLY ITEMS

- ▶ Glen has been reading his RDU and spoke on the re-birth of Vocational Service, Presidential 2-year terms, and a return to helping other groups with their efforts as we do for Meals on Wheels etc. Glen was thinking of such groups as Red Cross, Children's Hospital as examples; all of which generated general discussion.
- ▶ Soto, David Dunn and Brian Moodie have completed all of the repainting of the Pavilion. Soto is now looking to find 'a scrubber' for the floor.
- ▶ Soto is also in early discussions with the Mayor regarding some works around the Foreshore and Hummock Hill and involving school students. This led to further discussion regarding the state of Rotary Park and the Rotunda which is need of an upgrade.
- ▶ Another major project worth looking at is the Wetlands. Fai suggested we adopt a small section and show what can be done as an example and incentive to other groups to become involved.

- ▶ The final item under discussion was the Local Contact Directory which needs to begin its sales process to ensure it reaches the printers by the end of November. A meeting of the sales force was immediately scheduled following the conclusion of this meeting. Thanks to Tim for coordinating and David, Jane Jack, Keith and Glen for volunteering.
