ATTENDANCE AND APOLOGIES

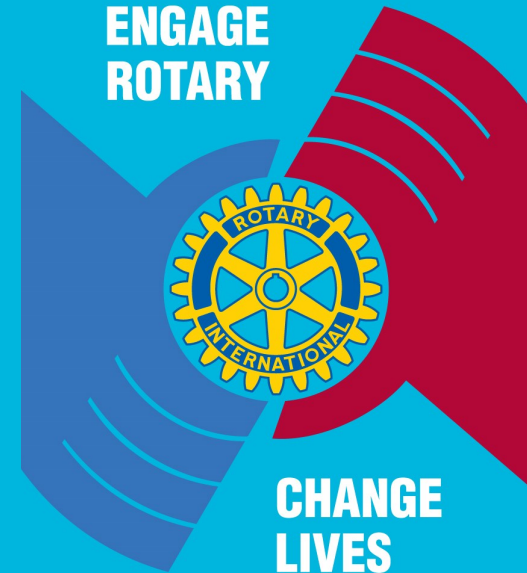

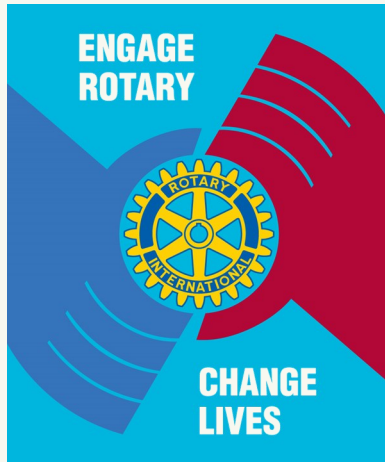
