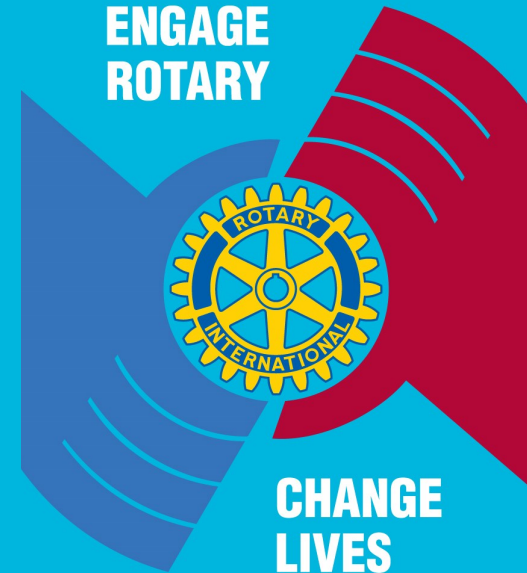

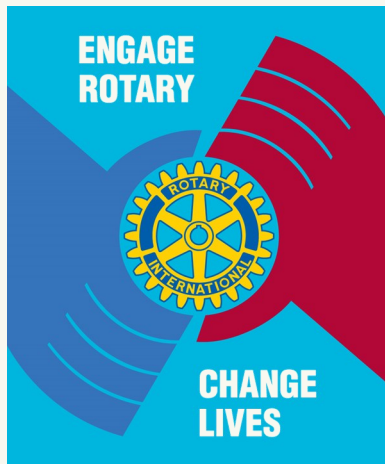

GUEST SPEAKER - Margot Stevenson - Parenting Support Program

Margot has had 20 years as a social worker and before that she was John Holds and John Cagney's best shop assistant.

The Parenting Support Program is Federally funded, which is always better than State funded because the money is greater.

The point of the program is to break the multigenerational bad habits with regard to parenting.

The parents love to turn up to the UniSA to receive their instruction because their peers may get the wrong impression that they are clever or something!

Margot also works with the Gabmitity Centre in Hinks Avenue.

The aim is to not deal with behavioural misdemeanours but to work with the inner Emotions. As an example, rather than bribe the kid to get him to get off the swing, explain to him how you also can feel his torment as he gets off the swing.

Margot regularly has 80 families in the program at any one time. Word of mouth works best as a referral for the Aboriginal Community.
