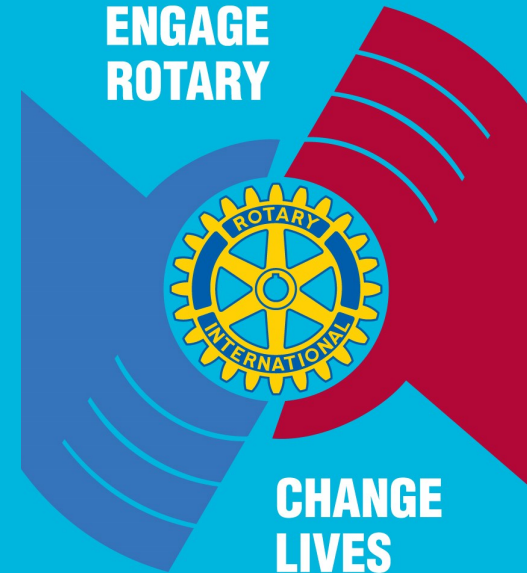

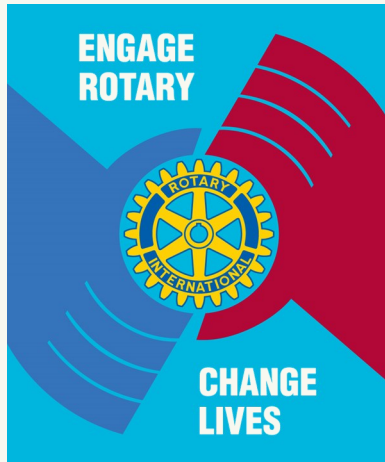

## LAST WEEK

### GUEST SPEAKER - Louise Osborn—Des's Regional Director on Des's 50th anniversary.

Louise started with Des's in 1989. She has a cert 3 in Accountancy and a cert 4 in Front Line Management.

Louise first started work at KFC, then in year 11 began as a vet's nurse where she got all the people skills necessary to one day run a taxi company.

Her first position at Des's was as a telephonist/receptionist. Within in 12 months of her being there the airline began, then Adelaide cabs and now minibuses are the big news in Adelaide.

Brett Brougham wrote the software for taxi control that has lasted these last 15 years.

May 2000 saw the crash of flight 904, the devastation to Des's and the eventual clearing of the charges of negligence.

2003 saw the buses begin, first 7, now 25. At this time Brett first was diagnosed with bowel cancer.

Louise did her study and then applied to be the first non-family director. In 2007 Brett died. Louise soon did the Company Director's course.

In 2007 Louise attended the Regional Leadership course, once a month for 8 months in different sites in our region.

Des's is community minded—it's pink taxi campaign raised \$20 000, and they have just planted 20 trees on the mad mile.

Des's has 70 taxis, 13 staff in the 24/7 radio room, 25 Hertz cars, 4 aircraft, 5 fulltime mechanics and Uncle Des.

Louise is responsible for 200 staff and drivers and 125 vehicle in this region and Des's has similar numbers in Adelaide.

Our Rotarian Tim is currently working on a "line of sight" carpark with the help of Arrium.

The taxis in Whyalla will get a modern radio system in Jan 2014. The 10 year bus contract is coming up for renewal soon.
