Bob — Show. The water heater is fixed in the van. The gas bottles are connected. Prices to be finalized. Roster is mainly filled.

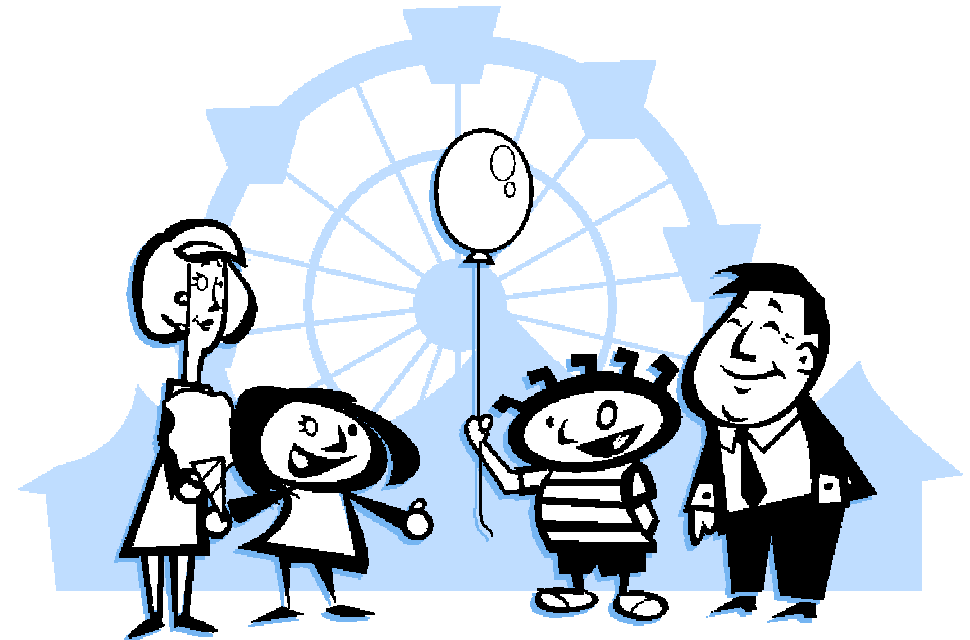
