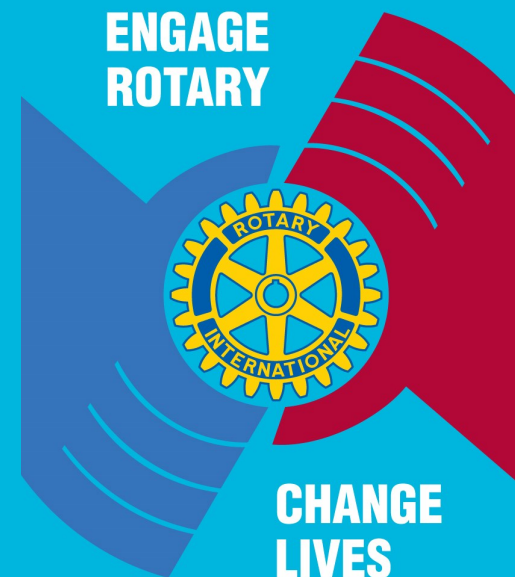

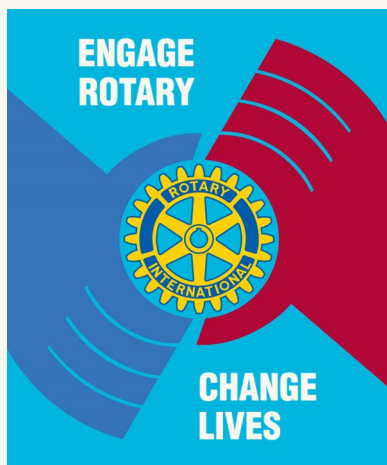

GUEST SPEAKER - Rona and John Gebbie - Safety Assist.

In 1986 Long st School started this in Whyalla, known then as safety house. They posted out letters to parents with three letters in each envelope so that the parents could give them to their neighbours each side, and the school saved two stamps for each delivery.

Onestop carpets, KFC, Sempre are also involved in Whyalla and they are not houses, so the name has changed to Safety Assist.

St Johns and DECS are on the Board.

Safety Assist in the other states have folded due to lack of interest.

There are 133 sites in Whyalla with only 22 joining in the last decade. In 1995 there were 200 sites.

Volunteers don't have to attend any meetings and pay no fees. They just need a police check.

The Safety Assist caravan fell into disuse and was outdated with regards to brakes until \$6000 was raised to get it road worthy again.
