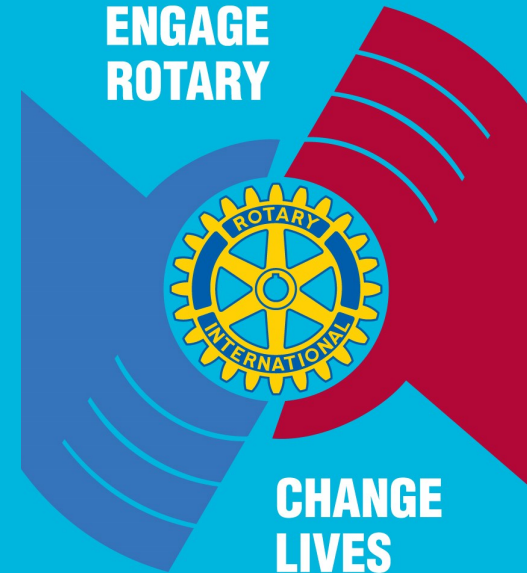

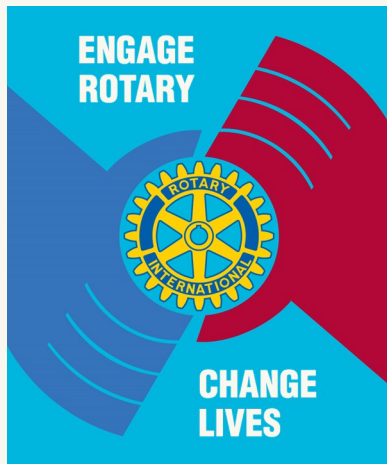

LAST WEEK

GUEST SPEAKER - Rohan Ramsey MP, Member for Grey

Rowan gave an honest appraisal of the working in Federal politics. commented that the electorate of Grey is getting bigger but its population is diminishing. He is worried about the survival of the SA electorate, and sees that the Agribusiness, currently growing at 2 ½% pa, Aquaculture and the Resources Boom (iron ore export of over \$100mtpa) will hold us in good stead. The impediments to this appear to be a deep sea port facility, water and Electricity. There has in his opinion a lack of Strategy focus by Governments in this area

They (Liberals) are looking at cutting the red tape by consolidating Federal Policy on States to fast track projects.

He believes that Education (foreign students) can be a big winner for the state.

The past few years have seen our exports fluctuating due to the high \$A, now that this has come down firms will make profits. He acknowledged the efforts that Arrium, Iron Road and Centrex have made in this difficult environment.

Brian Moody and Yari P raised numerous questions on parental leave to name just a few.

Bernadette Abraham also spoke on her campaign for the seat of Giles.
