ATTENDANCE AND APOLOGIES

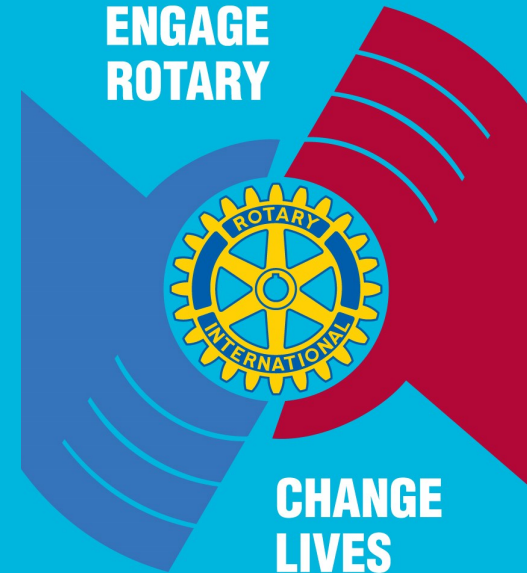

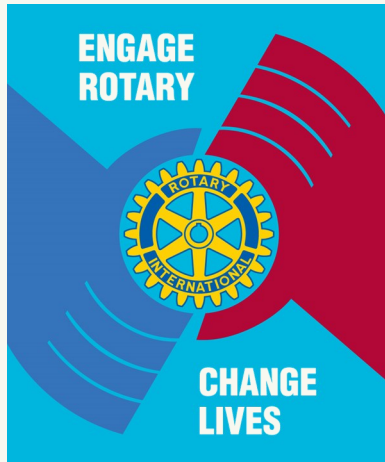

Finally found the Foreshore Motel after many U-turns.
Barbara started as a friend of Rotary in the apple and pear grower's industry organising conferences - she organised PDG Geoff Shahinger's conference and loved it. She then visited Geoff's Hindmarsh club for 5 years! (they didn't move fast) before the hard word was applied. Barbara was inducted in 2004, president elect after 6 months, then president twice in three years with treasurer in between.
Then onto District as Secretary, then Vice-Chair, Chair, DG nominee while Assistant Governor and now District Governor.
A fabulous journey.
Small clubs like us are the gems of the District. Adelaide Parks is where she is now, along with 4 others from the last 6 remaining in Hindmarsh before it closed, with PDG Don Sarah going to Adelaide.
Hindmarsh was vocation based rather than location based, so as the members retired from work, there was not much drawing them to the Hindmarsh area and consequently Rotary suffered.
DG training in San Diego contained 534 DGs and 533 Spouses (Barbara being the only single). The unmarried DG from Australia that brought her spouse had to get special dispensation—heaven help the first same sex DG in Rotary.
Two main points that all DGs are told to push:
RI Foundation & membership.
The polio campaign predicts no more cases of polio by end of 2015 3 years of being clear by end of 2018 and the cost will be \$16.5 billion, 15 of which is already raised.
Rotary Clubs need more diversity, be it young people, women or minorities.
One Club put an ad in the local paper for aspirants to come along - no takers. Then they put an ad in that said they had been inundated with enquires and please no more, and then got eight calls.
Whatever motivated you to join Rotary, share that with a potential member.
25000 people will be at the International Convention in Sydney in June - a great opportunity to get motivated by the throng.
